Host 1

- Responsible for Badger and Coyote campground loops and for selling firewood and ice
- Days off: Monday and Tuesday

Host 93

- Responsible for the Puma Campground loop, selling camper cabin rentals, and for selling firewood, ice
- Days off: Wednesday and Thursday

Days off are subject to change.

Host 1 and Host 93 Duties:

- Assist camper in locating vacant campsite
- Register all campers
- Sell firewood and ice
- Sell camper cabins
- Pull expired permits
- Answer questions
- Distribute brochures
- Keep a log of campers in your area
- Communicate with other host and park staff about concerns, needs, site availability, etc.
- Monitor cleanliness of showerhouses and notify park staff of any problems if necessary
- Monitor campground for rules violations and notify park ranger of any problems if necessary
- Pick up litter in your area and monitor ashes in fire pits
- Additional activities can be assigned

Handy Host 67

- Primary responsibility is to ensure that both shower houses and the 3 vault toilets located in the campground are kept clean. This requires host to clean both shower houses Friday morning, Friday evening, Saturday morning, Saturday evening, Sunday morning and Sunday evening. Host will also clean the vault toilets and the shower houses on Monday morning and Thursday morning.

- Also responsible for cleaning camper cabins throughout the week (except on days off) after guest check-out.
- Days off: Tuesday and Wednesday
- Provide park information to visitors.
- Perform the duties of Host 1 or Host 93 if those positions are vacant as directed by the park superintendent.
- Communicate with other host and park staff about concerns, needs, etc.
- Distribute brochures to racks located at both shower houses.
