- 1. Support campground management
 - Hang and remove reservation cards on campsite posts prior to arrival and after departure
 - Ensure guests are aware of park rules, notify staff of enforcement requirements
 - Light trash pick-up
 - Monitor restroom/shower house for cleanliness
 - May occasionally meet vendor for ice or firewood deliveries
 - Utilize provided golf cart and make staff aware of maintenance needs
- 2. Assist with sales in campground
 - Enter Campground Reservation System and Point of Sale data into computer to complete purchases
 - Utilize computer to complete credit card purchases
 - Provide ice and firewood sales to campground guests
 - Collect fees from campground guests and account for all money collected
 - Provide change and receipts for goods/services sold
- 3. Promote a safe, fun, and quality park experience
 - Greet campground visitors
 - Inform visitors about the park and park system, answer questions and hand out information as requested
 - Make staff aware of problems, ideas for improvement, and complaints
 - Camp hosts shall be model campers supporting all rules and regulations and setting a good example.
