Duties of Campground Host

- Act professionally and courteously while performing assigned duties
- Greet park visitors in a professional, courteous manner and disseminate information about park facilities and regulations when requested
- Assist park campers in locating vacant campsites
- Remove expired permits from campsite posts daily
- Collect camping fees, register campers into the registration system and post vacant cards and in-coming reservation tags
- Pick up trash and clean out fire rings
- Keep showerhouses swept out, stocked with paper towels and toilet tissue and wipe out sinks as needed
- Report any major messes, leaks or other repairs or problems to park staff

Duties of Handy Host

- Clean showerhouses and vault toilets when scheduled (Typically Saturday evening, but other days and times may be required).
- Clean fire pits. Use tractor or UTV to remove trash and ash from fire rings.
- Replace electrical breakers in campground pedestals when full time staff are not available.
- Blow leaves, use a weed eater to trim, and pick up litter, mainly in the campground.
- Provide coverage during off-peak times at the campground check station.
 Register campers, collect camping fees, and post vacant cards and in-coming reservation tags.
- Perform other duties, as agreed upon with park superintendent. (E.g. Trail maintenance, painting, staining, mowing, etc.)
- Work week: Thursday-Monday. Days off: Tuesday and Wednesday
- Duties and hours are subject to change
