

## Big Sugar Creek State Park

Celebrate the new year with a 3.3-mile hike on Ozark Chinquapin Trail! The hike will start at 9:30 a.m. and should last about three hours.

This trail is known to have water at several creek crossings during wet weather. Waterproof boots are strongly recommended. The trailhead is located on the south side of the park on Big Sugar Creek Road. Parking is available at the trailhead, as is a pit toilet.
