

Montauk State Park

Public meeting, 5 p.m., Sept. 18, 2025, in the Montauk Campground Amphitheater

The meeting was attended by 22 individuals, including members of the public, park staff, and park leadership, including State Park Deputy Director Justin Adams, Ozark Regional Director Larry Webb, and Ozark Deputy Director Brian Miller.

Of the 12 state or local elected officials invited, none were in attendance. Dave Tobey, board member of the Ozark Riverways Foundation was in attendance. No members of the press were in attendance.

In summary, Park Superintendent introduced staff and park leadership, reviewed highlights from the past year, including flood recovery and completion of electrical upgrades in campground loop four. He also summarized upcoming projects and programs, such as beginning of work on campground loop 5 and the 2026 Montauk Centennial. See attached agenda for complete list of topics reviewed.

During the question-and-answer period, a member of the public asked about flood evacuation procedures, which was addressed satisfactorily.
