Hosts can set up their RV next to our maintenance building and use the break room, refrigerator, bathroom, shower and free laundry facilities in the building. It also serves as a storm shelter. We will work with hosts to match their skills and interests with needs of the park, therefore a host does not need to do all that is listed below. Rather we will draw from the lists below to create a customized list for you.

Handy Host Duties:

- Mow day use areas and trailheads with riding lawn mower and weedeater. Option to also mow trails and fire lines with a small tractor.
- Patrol and pick up trash in the park day use areas. Stock park maps.
- Check restrooms for cleanliness and stock with toilet tissue as needed.
- Hang and remove reservation cards on shelters posts prior to arrival and after departure of groups.
