

Bothwell Lodge State Historic Site Accessibility Information

Bothwell Lodge

Bothwell Lodge provides a mostly level parking lot with an accessible water fountain and information kiosk located adjacent to it. The nearby restroom has front-transfer toilets; but has only a 3-foot passageway and the lavatories are difficult to reach.

From the parking lot, a path leads to the lodge in two directions with the lower path being of wood chips with no slopes exceeding 5 percent. Steps lead into the east wing of the lodge, where an interpretive video may be viewed. Flipbooks are available for viewing. Various park information is available and books, souvenirs and pictures may be purchased. The lodge, being constructed in the late 1880s, has four levels with short, steep steps and narrow doorways. Modifications cannot be made without altering the historical fabric of the structure; therefore, the lodge may not be accessible to all visitors.

Day-Use Area 🕭

Here you will find a shelter equipped with extended-end tables and a group grill that can be reserved for up to 74 people. A paved pathway leads to the shelter, a water fountain and the accessible restroom from a handicap parking space. The restroom has lever-handled faucets and front-transfer toilets.

An accessible picnic site with an extended-end table and a pedestal grill is located in the same area.

The playground has not yet been modified for accessibility.
