

Dillard Mill State Historic Site Accessibility Information

The symbol indicates that the specified area is fully compliant with Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG).

Office 🖶

As you enter the site grounds, the historic site office will be up a drive on the right. A handicap parking space of packed gravel fines has been provided adjacent to a boardwalk leading to the entrance. Inside, a video tour of the site and its history is provided.

Picnic Area 🖶

An easily accessible picnic shelter located at the end of the day-use parking lot provides a handicap parking space, an extended-end table and a pedestal grill. Two handicap accessible vault toilets are on the east side of the parking lot near this shelter.

A group picnic site, located across the low-water bridge, offers a view of the mill and is accessible upon gaining permission to drive across the stream. This site provides a long table with an extended end and a pedestal grill.

Path

A loose gravel path leads from the day-use parking lot to the mill. A 4-inch high concrete water barrier must be crossed to access the path. As you pass through the information kiosk, the path becomes steeper with a 9.8 percent slope for a distance of 35 feet. Benches are placed along the path for resting.

Another vault toilet sits just below the mill and can be driven to with permission. Parking is on gravel. This vault toilet has not been modified for accessibility at this time. The gravel path ends at the mill after climbing a varying slope of 4 to 7.3 percent.

Mill

With permission, visitors may drive to the mill where a 10-foot long wood ramp with a 10.3 percent slope is provided for access to the porch. The first floor of the mill is accessible, where you can view the actual machinery and components used.
