Elephant Rocks State Park Accessibility Information

Picnic Area

Four handicap parking spaces provide easy access to an information kiosk containing literature and exhibits of the park's history. Braille text is provided. The kiosk sits on a slight slope.

A paved path leads past a water fountain to an accessible vault and flush toilets. One individual and one group picnic site, located among the trees, have been modified with pavement and extended-end tables. The playground is not accessible at this time.

Interpretive Trail

The path through the site is asphalt and has varying slopes and conditions. The most excessive slopes are at 9.3 percent for 37 feet and 10.2 percent for 20 feet. At some points, the trail pinches down to 28 inches wide, due to the rock formations.

Along the trail are interpretive stations with Braille text. Carpet patches followed by a hand-rope mark stations and changes in the pathway. Most of the one-mile long trail is shady and places are provided for rest.
