



### HOW OFTEN DO YOU VISIT THIS STATE PARK?




### WHEN YOU VISIT THIS STATE PARK, WHO USUALLY JOINS YOU?







Staffing Needs: The current team does a fantastic job, but it's clear the park is understaffed for the level of programming, interpretation, and maintenance that the local community would like to see. Increasing staffing would help the site meet demand and expand offerings for visitors. Increased Programming: Additional events and guided tours could help attract more families, school groups, and heritage tourists year-round.
